Christian Service Requirement

2011-2012

Christian Service is a vital part of the educational process at Linfield Christian School. Christ has directed us to grow in an attitude of servanthood (*If anyone wants to be first, he must be last of all and servant of all – Mark 9:35*)

All students are required to volunteer for a minimum of twenty (20) documented hours of service FOR EACH LINFIELD SCHOOL YEAR ATTENDED. This change was effective September 2008. ***This annual requirement must be met in order to receive a current report card for grade completion and to select courses for the following school year.*** Updates will be mailed home quarterly with report cards.

- Opportunities should be sought which DO NOT include service to family members or at school-related events.(see exceptions below*)
- Service hours may not be acquired through time spent serving in a class the student is currently enrolled. (i.e. ASB).
- Sports camps are fundraisers and therefore are not considered community service.

We encourage our students to go far beyond these required hours of service as it creates a connection to our community and benefits others. An extensive list of Christian Service opportunities is available in the High School Office.

Note: For approval of other service opportunities or projects, please see the Vice Principal prior to completion of service. **Please return the completed form to the Attendance Office.**

DEADLINES: -Christian Service hours to be included in Senior Portfolio are due no later than January 20, 2012
-Christian Service hours to be included for the Presidential Service Award are due no later than April 16, 2012
-All Christian Service hours for 2010-2011 must be submitted by May 15, 2012

GUIDELINES: Students may complete their hours TWO different ways:

- (1) Service opportunities that are not connected to Linfield
 - Teaching/assist with a Sunday School class
 - Community Clean-up projects
 - Community Service Organization
 - Food Pantry
 - Habitat for Humanity
 - Recycling projects
- (2) Service opportunities provided throughout the year through Linfield.
 - Samaritan's Purse
 - Senior Center (cards, visits, etc.)
 - Community meetings
 - Bake Sales
 - Letters to Troops
 - Lion Ministries (Blood Drive)
 - Mission Trips
 - Campus Clean-up (as scheduled)
 - Auction*
 - Golf Tournament*
