

Summer Remediation Classes

If your student has earned a 'D' or 'F' during high school (or may earn a 'D' or 'F' in this semester) our recommendation is that the course (or semester) be remediated. This will afford your student the greatest number of opportunities beyond high school graduation. **The first step** is to talk to your student's high school counselor to determine if summer school is the best option.

Please continue to monitor My Backpack regularly for your student's grade and progress to determine if remediation is necessary.

There will be an information night for summer remediation students in room 207 on Tuesday, May 30 at 6:00 p.m.

Summer school sessions run from June 12 through August 27 (most classes are 8 -10 weeks). The length and start/end dates are determined by the course that is being taken.

Summer school cost is \$475 per semester course.
