



Theater Arts

1. Complete four advancing levels of theater arts courses (theater and/or dance)
2. Complete at least one Advanced Fine Arts Academy class (either AP or Honors as described in the Discipline Pathways)
3. Complete one additional **intra-disciplinary** elective (ex: a theater student takes an additional dance course)
OR **cross-disciplinary** Fine Arts elective (ex: a dancer takes a graphic design course)
4. Participate in two auditioned theatre productions each year
5. Participate in one production beyond the required participation for the Theater Arts courses
6. Complete 40 verified hours of private vocal/dance/drama instruction (10 hours per year)
7. Attend two outside plays, musicals, or other theatre productions each year. Submit a one-page essay review of the event.
8. Participate in required field trips to local theatres and festivals
9. Attend at least one other performance/festival/show/event of other Linfield Fine Arts Academy concentrations in support of Fine Arts Academy colleagues
10. Participate in one arts outreach or volunteer opportunity each year (opportunities vary each year)
11. Participate in one of the following during the four-year program:
 - Interview or shadow an actor or music theatre performer
 - Pre-college Summer Program offered by Art Colleges including CalArts, UCLA, Parsons, SCAD, etc.
 - Series of Workshops or Classes at local theatres or institutions
12. Complete prescribed "co-credit" LCFAA courses that meet both the LCHS general graduation requirements and LCFAA requirements:
 - World History/World History Honors/AP European History – supplementary assignments required for LCFAA student portfolio
 - Art in the Bible/Philosophy of Christian Art (one-year Bible elective) – offered in 2020-21
13. CLASS OF 2020-21 AND BEYOND: Seniors Only Showcase – second semester – Collaborate with other Academy seniors to create, write, produce, and perform in a final theatre production or other approved media production. *(Note: Jeni Sheldrake has added showcases for Honors Advanced Theatre students. This showcase will be similar, except for seniors only, and extends an opportunity for students to collaborate with fine arts students in other disciplines as well.)*
