

AP Studio Art Summer Assignment

Things that are changing in AP this year:

- AP Studio Art: 2-D Design, AP Studio Art: 3-D Design and AP Studio Art: Drawing will become **AP 2-D Art and Design, AP 3-D Art and Design, and AP Drawing. (photography is part of the 2-D Art and Design portfolio)**
- The portfolios will now have two sections: Sustained Investigation and Selected Works.
- Your students will submit fewer required works of art, giving them more time to focus on in-depth, inquiry-based art and design making.
- Sustained Investigation (60% of exam score) for all three portfolios, students will submit images and writing to document their inquiry-guided investigation through practice, experimentation, and revision: with 15 digital images that include works of art and design and process documentation.

What you need to do this summer:

- Brainstorm three different concepts for your sustained investigation
- Write one paragraph (five sentences) explaining each concept. This means three paragraphs total.
- Below is a link to a website I want you to read through, this will help you come up with your concepts.

- Create one artwork/photograph for each concept (three artworks total).
- Each artwork/photograph must reflect one of your concepts
- The three concepts and artworks/photographs will be due the first day of class.
