

1. Go to the Library and check out your APUSH textbook from Mrs. McGraw *American Pageant*, ed. Kennedy and Cohen. You will also need to purchase a review workbook through the school. It's called *United States History: Preparing for the Advanced Placement Examination, 2018 Edition* by Amsco Publishing.
2. Go to Edmodo.com and create an account and/or join our group from your existing account. Our group is called **19 APUSH** and the code for joining is **gb5h5q**. *If that code doesn't work (it may expire partway through the summer), then just e-mail me and I'll accept you into the class.* This site will be our connection over the summer. All instructions and assignments will be posted there and if you need to get in touch with me, you may use Edmodo.com to leave me a message. You may also send your questions to kmullen@linfield.com as I will be checking my e-mail regularly.
3. You will be doing Unit #1 over the summer...so my advice is **DON'T** wait until the last week of the summer vacation to start on the work! I would recommend that you begin soon after July 4th and complete one chapter's work each week.
 - A. Read Chapter 1 (p. 2—24) and do the homework assignment, which is posted on Edmodo.com. Upload your work to Edmodo.com and take the Ch. 1 Quiz (also on Edmodo.com).
 - B. Read Chapter 2 (p. 25—42) and do the homework assignment for that chapter, which is posted on Edmodo.com. Upload your work to Edmodo.com and take the Ch. 2 Quiz.
 - C. Read Chapter 3 (p. 43—63) and do the homework assignment for that chapter, which is posted on Edmodo.com. Upload your work and take the Ch. 3 Quiz.
 - D. Read Chapter 4 (p. 66—83) and do the homework assignment for that chapter, which is posted on Edmodo.com. Upload your work and take the Ch. 4 Quiz.
 - E. Read Chapter 5 (p. 84—104) and do the homework assignment for that chapter, which is posted on Edmodo.com. Upload your work and take the Ch. 5 Quiz.

IMPORTANT: If you cannot submit your work by uploading to Edmodo.com, please bring hard copies of all the completed assignments to school on Tuesday, August 20, 2019.
