Organized under FEMA, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Linfield Christian School has been a CERT facility since 2007.



CAHAN is the emergency planning, alerting and notification system for the California Department of Public Health, Emergency Preparedness Office. It serves as a single, central point for finding, creating, and sharing information. CAHAN has been deployed to provide alerting, notification and emergency preparation tools for state and local officials. Linfield Christian School was added to this network in 2009.

MASTER PLAN

Linfield Christian School is included the City Emergency Plan as an overnight ‘safe-haven’ facility for overflow Fire & Rescue personnel and equipment. During the fall '07 fire storms, Linfield Christian School provided showers, food, hygiene products, pillows, an air conditioned gym, and secured campus for emergency vehicles to out-of-state fire support personnel. The City agreed to include LCS in the City Emergency Plan in 2008.

RAPID RESPONSE PROGRAM

Linfield Christian School has participated in this program since 2007. The PDRR program lists all critical information, contacts, utility locations, security codes, command post, student staging areas, and traffic control points on the LCS campus. That information along with digital pictures of every area on campus is stored in the secured Police data system and available to every police vehicle.
