Dear 2018-2019 Fourth Grade Parents,

We are delighted to offer an exceptional learning experience as part of our Fourth Grade California Studies Program and we want our parents to be aware of this “super” field trip early so that they can begin planning now. Our fourth grade students and parents will be flying to Sacramento, CA, for a two-day overnight trip that is scheduled for Wednesday, April 24 – Thursday, April 25, 2019. This field trip will be provided through Academy National Tours, a full-service Christian travel organization.

This year’s fourth graders just recently returned from this trip and were so excited to have visited the California State Capitol, Wells Fargo Bank Museum, Sacramento Old Town, Historic Buildings, California State Railroad Museum, Leland Stanford Mansion, Sutter’s Fort, and James Marshall State Historic Park (which included panning for gold in the American River), as well as shopped in Old Town Sacramento and shared the plane trip and overnight experiences with their classmates.

Full information about the 2018-2019 trip will be posted in August on the fourth grade webpage: linfield4.org. With a minimum of 70 participants, the estimated cost per student will be around \$625 and \$655 for each adult, based on current airfare pricing and subject to change. At this time, our plans are to depart and return from the Ontario International Airport using Southwest Airlines.

It has been our experience that fourth graders will need one-on-one supervision in Sacramento. In addition to the educational value, this trip fosters a wonderful opportunity for parent-child bonding. If you or an adult relative are unable to accompany your child on this excursion, we regret to inform you that your child will not be able to participate.

We are already excited about enjoying this learning experience with you and your child!
